

Defendant Brock Pierce's motion pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(f) for an order striking certain allegations of the complaint of Plaintiff Alan Debonneville ("Plaintiff") came on for hearing on September 4, 2007 before this Court in Courtroom 218, the Honorable Manuel L. Real, United States District Court Judge. presiding. The court reviewed the moving, opposition and reply papers, including all supporting papers submitted therewith, and considered only admissible and competent supporting evidence. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: The Motion is GRANTED. The following allegations in Plaintiff's Complaint are hereby stricken:

- Paragraphs 4, 5, 7, 15, 16, and 19-27; 1.
- 2. The section titles in the Fact section of the Complaint entitled "The Luring" 13 In" (at p. 6); "Pierce's Greed Manifests Itself" (at p. 14); "Pierce's Bait and Switch" (at 14 p. 15); "Pierce's Great Cover-Up" (at p. 22); "Pierce's Deception Is Discovered" (at p. 15||25); "Pierce Reveals His Master Plan" (at p. 26); and "The Trading Arm Heist" (at p. 29);
 - All references to "Bait and Switch" and "Fiduciary True-Up" in the 3. Complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

Plaintiffs' Complaint be sealed and Plaintiff is required to file an amended complaint consistent with the Court's order within 10 days of the date of entry of this order.
