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**JOINT STIPULATION WITH ATTACHED ORDER  
ADOPTING JOINT STIPULATION AS ORDER OF COURT**

This Joint Stipulation is made between Plaintiff Antonio Hernandez (“Hernandez”) and Defendant IGE U.S. LLC n/k/a Affinity Media Holdings, LLC (“IGE U.S.”) (together, “the Parties”). The Parties have reached an agreement to fully and finally dispose of this action on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth in a certain Settlement Agreement and Release. Among other things, the Parties have agreed as follows:

1. That the individual claims of Hernandez will be dismissed with prejudice, and the claims of the putative classes will be dismissed without prejudice, upon the Parties’ execution of the Settlement Agreement and Release and the filing of a Joint Stipulation of Dismissal with this Court; and
2. That while IGE U.S. has denied engaging in any improper activities, IGE U.S. has confirmed that it has no plans, and therefore will not, engage in the selling of *World of Warcraft*

virtual property or currency (commonly referred to as “gold,” “gold farming,” “real money trade” or “RMT”) for a period of five (5) years.

A proposed Order adopting this Joint Stipulation as and Order of the Court is attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”
